JUNIOR HIGH Business Classroom Rules

- 1. FOLLOW SCHOOL RULES
- 2. DISPLAY PROPER BUSINESS BEHAVIOR
- 3. DEMONSTRATE BUSINESS PRODUCTIVITY

Business Behavior Consequences

- 1st offense Warning "There is a Better Choice"
- (1 per week)
- 2nd offense Lose one business behavior point for that day
- 3rd offense Lose a second business behavior point for that day
- 4th offense Parent/guardian will be contacted OR Office Referral

At the discretion of the teacher, a student can receive an office referral at any time if it disrupts classroom learning.

Business Behavior consists of . . .

- 1. Listening when someone else is talking
- Keeping all body parts (arms, legs, etc.) away from others and their space
- 3. Respecting equipment by using it for what it is intended
- 4. Refraining from making distracting noises from any body parts
- 5. Walking correctly from place to place in the room
- 6. Raising hand if you have a question or would like a turn to speak
- 7. Maintaining relative stillness when sitting
- 8. Doing independent work when instructed
- 9. Being polite to others through speech, gestures, personal space

Business Productivity Consequences

1st offense – Warning "There is a Better Choice" (1 per week)

2nd offense and thereafter – Lose one business productivity point for the day

3rd offense - Lose a second business behavior point for the day

4th offense - Parent/guardian will be contacted OR Office Referral

Business Productivity consists of ...

 Completing work assigned in class including independent and group work. Work will consist of worksheets, ipad/computer activities, discussions, keyboarding practice, etc.



STUDENTS earn 4 points each day class is in session.

- 2 points for Business Behavior
- 2 points for Business Productivity

Business Behavior points CANNOT be earned back.

Business Productivity points MAY BE earned back if the student meets with the teacher to determine a plan to complete the work.

MAKE-UP WORK

- Students excused for school activities will not be required to complete make up work.
- Students with excused absences can complete a task from the make up activities list located in Google classroom and submit it via email to Mrs. Griffith.
- Students with unexcused absences are unable to complete makeup work.

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
